

## 7-YEAR B.S. / PHARM. D. PROGRAM

The UCSD Chemistry & Biochemistry Department and the Skaggs School of Pharmacy have a specialized 7-Year Bachelor of Science/Doctor of Pharmacy Program. This program combines 4 years of Undergraduate work and 4 years of Pharmacy School into 7 years. If admitted to the program, students will begin Pharmacy School during their 4th year at UCSD.

### Qualifications for the specialized program:

- Must be majoring in Biochemistry/Chemistry or Pharmacological Chemistry.  
(Students in other majors must declare one of the CHEM majors listed above to qualify.)
- Must be a U.S. citizen / U.S. permanent resident at time of application.  
(Currently, the UCSD Skaggs School of Pharmacy is not accepting international students.)
- Must have a minimum 3.50 overall GPA and complete the following courses **at UCSD** by the end of the second year (*AP coursework may satisfy these requirements*):
  - CHEM 6A, 6B, 6C & 6BL
  - CHEM 140A, 140B, 140C & 143A
  - MATH 20A, 20B, 20C, 20D
  - PHYS 2A, 2B, 2D & 2CL
  - BILD 1 & 2
  - CHEM 92 (1-Unit Undergraduate Pharmacology Seminar)

\* If qualifications are met, students may apply for the specialized program at the end of their second year at UCSD. (*Transfer students cannot apply*)

If you feel you can complete all of the previously mentioned requirements then we encourage you to inquire about the program.

You must contact an Undergraduate Advisor from the Department of Chemistry & Biochemistry to ensure you will be taking the correct courses for your first three years at UCSD. It is crucial that you meet with an advisor from Chemistry & Biochemistry within your first year at UCSD to get the full details about the program.
